**TO THE MEMBERS OF THE REPUBLICAN NATIONAL COMMITTEE AND THOSE
DESIGNATED TO PARTICIPATE:**

In accordance with *The Rules of the Republican Party*, adopted on July 15, 2024, by the delegates at the Republican National Convention and amended on January 23, 2026, by the Republican National Committee, the Chairman of the Republican National Committee hereby issues this Call for a **special ceremonial convention** of the Republican Party, to convene in Dallas, Texas, on Wednesday, September 9, 2026, and to continue on Thursday, September 10, 2026.

This special ceremonial convention is called for the purpose of celebrating the accomplishments of President Trump and rallying behind a shared vision for America's future.

CONVENING OF THE SPECIAL CEREMONIAL CONVENTION

RULE NO. 13

Call of Next Convention

This Call is issued under the second clause of Rule No. 13 of *The Rules of the Republican Party*, which provides:

“A special ceremonial convention may be called by the Chairman of the Republican National Committee provided that a call is issued by the Chairman at least sixty (60) days in advance. The Chairman shall designate the membership in a special convention, and no business shall be conducted at such a convention. The Rules of the Republican Party and parliamentary procedure shall not otherwise apply to such a convention.”

TERMS OF THIS CALL

Sixty (60) Days' Notice. This Call is issued by the Chairman not less than sixty (60) days in advance of the convening of the special ceremonial convention on September 9, 2026, in satisfaction of Rule No. 13.

Designation of Membership. Pursuant to Rule No. 13, the Chairman of the Republican National Committee shall designate the membership of this special ceremonial convention. The membership shall consist solely of those persons so designated by the Chairman and shall be empowered to take no formal action.

No Business Conducted. In accordance with Rule No. 13, the convention is convened for ceremonial and celebratory purposes only, and the participants therein shall take no action, adopt no resolution, conduct no election, and transact no other business of any kind.

Rules and Procedure Not Otherwise Applicable. In accordance with Rule No. 13, *The Rules of the Republican Party* and parliamentary procedure shall not otherwise apply to this special ceremonial convention, except as to the provisions of Rule No. 13 governing the issuance of this Call, the designation of membership, and the prohibition on the conduct of business.

TIME AND PLACE

The special ceremonial convention shall convene no earlier than 8:00 a.m. and no later than 9:00 p.m. Central Daylight Time in **Dallas, Texas**, on **Wednesday, September 9, 2026**, and shall continue on **Thursday, September 10, 2026**, unless otherwise directed by the Chairman of the Republican National Committee.
